Do's and Don'ts for Wardrobe for Headshots

Do this...

- Bring way more options of clothing than necessary (example: for 3 looks bring enough for 10)
- Have your clothes steamed, iron, and on hangers ready to go
- Layers are amazing (jean jackets, jean vest, leather jackets, ZIPPED hoodies, etc..)
- Great colors that photograph well on most people are blues, greens, purples, reds, and black.
- Ladies: Basic colored tanks work great (Forever 21 has great deals on tanks that come in fun colors)
- Also ladies: make sure to bring the appropriate bra or bras for all clothing in your looks
- Guys: V-necks look amazing!
- Kids: You guys can pretty much get away with any style shirt so feel free to bring a variety of style options.
- If you wear glasses normally bring them, if you can pop the lenses out of them. (That way there won't be any glare!)
- Plain and simple is key (remember the focus is on your face not the clothes!)

Don't do this...

- Bring bright neon colors (neon green, yellow or orange) or busy patterns (they take away from your beautiful face)
- Use turtlenecks, scarves, fur, or crazy jewelry.
- Bring clothes that are too worn, wrinkled, or stained
- Select wardrobe options that are overly big on you or don't fit you right
- Wear logos!! Plain and simple is the best option! (Target has great plain shirts for this)
